Bob and Carol Kunath have owned about a dozen sail and powerboats over the past 45 years. They've ranged from small open lake boats to those equipped for offshore shark and sport fishing, to sail and powerboats on Lake Michigan where they have been cruising for the past twenty-five years. During those years they have cruised extensively throughout Lake Michigan and the North Channel of Lake Huron. Both are Past Commodores of the Bay Shore Yacht Club in Illinois, and members of the Waukegan, IL and Venice, FL Sail and Power Squadrons, where Bob, a Sr. Navigator, has served as an officer, instructor and editor; and the Racine, WI Yacht Club. He has contributed to *Latitudes and Attitudes*, the *USPS Ensign*, *Southern Boating* and holds a USCG Master's license. During 2005 they completed a two-year cruise of the Great Loop in their Pacific Seacraft 38T trawler, *Sans Souci*, logging 9,000 miles on the Loop and many side trips. They have resumed cruising all of Lake Michigan, but are also exploring the Gulf Coast of Florida in a small boat based in Venice, their winter home. Bob and Carol have been popular seminar presenters at Trawlerfest, U. S. Power Squadron, M. T. O. A. and America's Great Loop Cruising Assn. events, sharing their knowledge of Lake Michigan, the Great Loop and cruising. For the past eight years they have covered Eastern and Western Lake Michigan including Green Bay and Door County as Cruising Editors for *Waterway Guide*. Bob and Carol also updated and revised *Skipper Bob's Lake Michigan*, 2010 edition.
